



# IMPORTANT BOOKING INFORMATION - WINTER

## DRIVER'S LICENSE 19+ DRIVERS

Persons going as a single rider must be at least 19 years old with a full, valid driver's license (equivalent to a BC Class 5). All drivers who are under 25 years are required to show their license upon check in.

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER FORM MANDATORY



It is mandatory for all tour participants to sign a Release of Liability and Waiver Form. Any participants under the age of 19 must have parent or guardian present to sign on their behalf.

## HELMETS MANDATORY



All Snowmobile tour participants must wear a Department of Transport Safety Approved Full Faced Helmet while on tour. Dogsled participants are required to wear a protective helmet, such as a bicycle or ski/snowboard helmet.

## ALCOHOL MARIJUANA UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES



Any person suspected to be under the influence of any drugs, marijuana or alcohol will not be permitted to participate in any tours. Persons denied participation will not receive a refund.

## CANCELLATION POLICY



Full payment is due at time of booking. Refunds and cancellations by guests are limited to 24hrs prior to departure. Canadian Wilderness Adventures reserves the right to cancel tours due to inclement weather, insufficient bookings or events beyond our control. If your tour is cancelled by Canadian Wilderness Adventures, you will be issued a full refund.

## \$35 PER DRIVER, PER TOUR COLLISION COVERAGE / FUEL SURCHARGE

ZERO-DEDUCTIBLE Mandatory on all Snowmobile tours. Collision Coverage \$45 per driver for the Powderhound & Bralorne tours.



## LANGUAGE POLICY



All groups require a minimum of one translator to interpret the waiver. Snowmobile tours require one translator per guided group. Snowcat/Dogsled/Snowshoe groups do not require translators on tour however they do require a translator for the waiver process. Translators are required to be 19+ years and speak both English and the language of the group fluently enough to translate safety instructions and procedures.

## PREGNANCY



Safety regulations require that Canadian Wilderness Adventures not permit pregnant women to ride as driver or passenger on a Snowmobile or Dogsled tour.

All mothers to be are **WELCOME** on our Snowcat and Snowshoe tours.

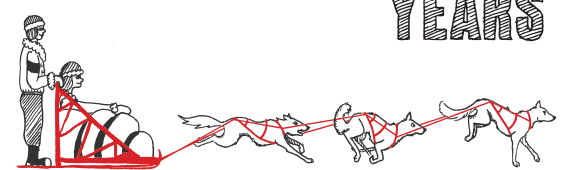

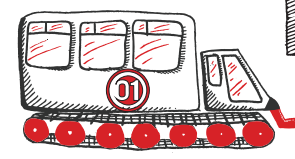
